---

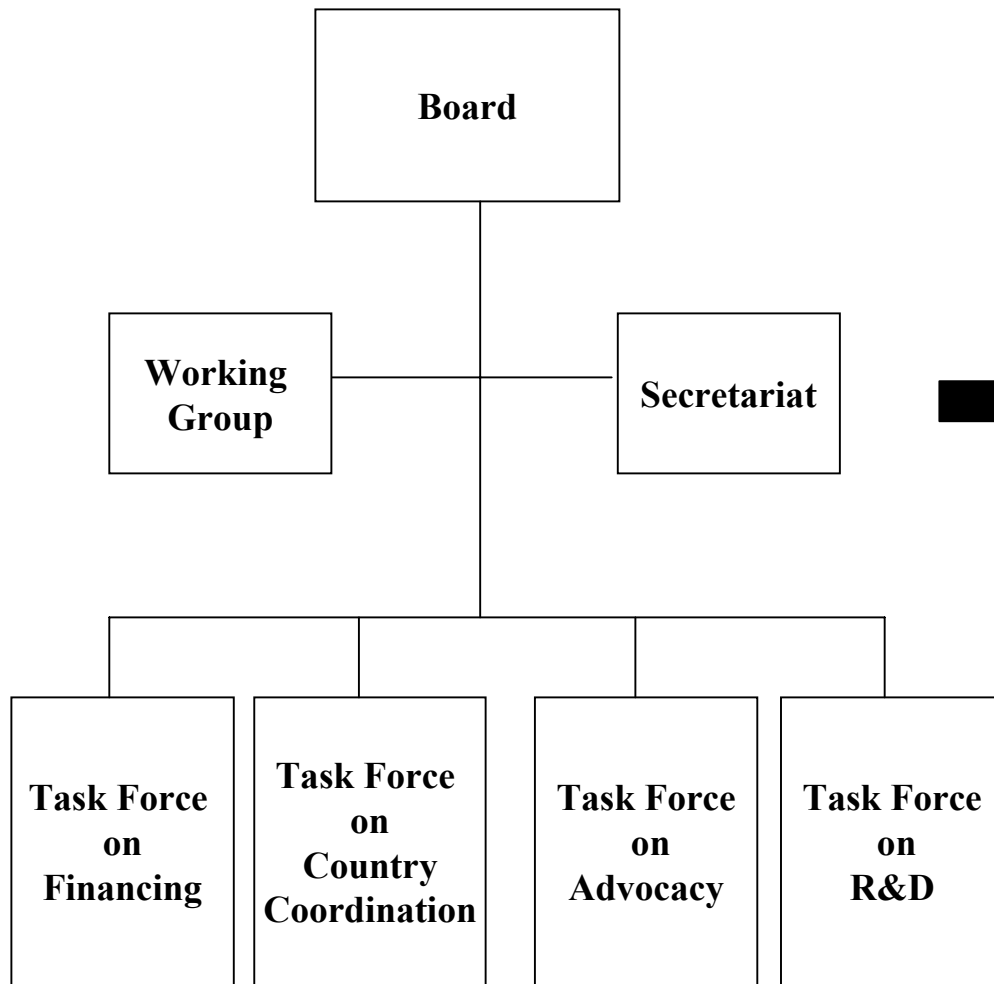
- Improve access to sustainable immunization services

## **Secretariat**

- Implement the directions of the Board
- Ensure the involvement and representation of the broader immunization community;

## **Task Forces**

- Address cross-cutting issues: financing, coordination at country level, R&D, advocacy
